The plan is to take off from Sedro Woolley at 8:30

Stop for a potty break in Newhalem and be headed out at 9:45

Stop at milepost 166 (at the top of Washington Pass) and not leave there until everyone catches up about 11:00

Then it is a nice down hill drive into Winthrop and we will stop in the park on the way into town for Lunch. We would then be free to set by the river or walk through uptown Winthrop to check out the great little shops. We should then meet at Sheri's for Ice Cream or baked goods about 1:00, before getting ready to head home.

We felt it would be fun to stop at the look out on Washington Pass on the way home to make sure everyone got up the hill. There are a few wineries and a brewery stop if anyone might enjoy on the way home. Lots of look out and pull over place to see the great views.
